

Electrical Craft Training Level 2



INTRODUCTION

This is a qualification that has been developed by an industry approved awarding body. It is aimed at providing the underpinning knowledge to students who wish to have a career in the Electrical Industry.

WHAT WILL I DO

Attend College on a full-time basis to study theoretical and practical electrical installation.

The units completed for the full qualification are:

- Roles, responsibilities and procedures
- Safe working practices
- Environmental protection measures
- Fundamental scientific principles

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE

The Level 2 qualification should be achieved in one year on a full-time basis.

ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

A relevant Level 1 vocational qualification or 4GCSE's at grade A- D to include Maths and English.

Applicants should provide a good reference and successfully complete an interview. Applicants will also complete an aptitude test, where they will have demonstrated abilities and an interest in the subject.

Entry to the Evening provision is through the Pre-Vocational evening course and associated assessment at the end of the course.

WHERE COULD IT LEAD

Successful students can progress onto the Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship, or to Semi-Skilled status employment within the electrical industry.

FEES

Full time Courses are free for those who are under 19 on 31 August of the year they start their course. For others, fees may vary depending on personal circumstances. Please enquire for details.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

For workshop activities you will need to purchase your own safety footwear and protective clothing that meet the course requirements. For classroom activities you will need to provide stationary and writing materials.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Where courses last for more than one year, only the first years fees are shown.
