

NCFE Certificate Airline Cabin Crew Level 2



INTRODUCTION

This certificate forms a compulsory part of the BTEC National Certificate in Travel and Tourism, but may also be studied on a part time basis.

The NCFE certificate prepares candidates for entry to the airline industry. It is not intended as a replacement to the training given by airlines but provides the basic background skills, knowledge and understanding required to work effectively as a member of airline cabin crew. It is ideal for those seeking employment or for those wishing to enhance their studies in travel and tourism.

WHAT WILL I DO?

The certificate consists of 6 compulsory units:

- Understand the airline industry and the role of airline cabin crew.
- Promote effective customer care in the airline industry.
- Maintain effective team working and communications in the airline industry.
- Contribute to the health and safety of airline passengers.
- Contribute to aviation security.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the airport arrival process.

These 6 units are assessed internally by the production of a portfolio of evidence.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE

This course is offered over 30 weeks on a Part-time & Supplementary basis on Wednesdays. Times TBC.

ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

Part time applicants should demonstrate a proven commitment, enthusiasm and suitability for the profession and supply a positive reference.

WHERE COULD IT LEAD

Successful candidates should find their prospects of employment in the airline industry enhanced. Those meeting bmi criteria will be guaranteed an interview.
