

Brickwork Initial Craft Training Level 1



INTRODUCTION

You can choose to study this course at either **Boston College**, Skirbeck Road, Boston or **Red Lion Quarter**, Spalding.

This full-time course leads to a Level 1 Diploma in Brickwork and aims to prepare you for employment and further craft training in the Construction industry.

WHAT WILL I DO

The course is made up of several units. All units include practical activities in brickwork. A hands on approach will be adapted by all learners in the achievement of the qualification. Facilities for training include construction workshops and a learning resource room. All students will have access to information on study skills and study support groups if required.

You will have a Personal Tutor to help support your learning.

Exams are set by the Awarding Body. All work is assessed, when required, by College based assessors. All work can be re-assessed if required without delay.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE

This course is full-time for one year during which you should achieve the qualification.

ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

3 GCSE's at grade D – F to include Maths and English, or a vocational qualification at a similar level.

Applicants should provide a good reference and successfully complete an interview. Applicants will also complete an aptitude test, where they will have demonstrated abilities and an interest in the subject.

WHERE COULD IT LEAD

Successful students will usually continue their training full or part-time to level 2 qualifications.

FEES

Full time Courses are free for those who are under 19 on 31 August of the year they start their course. For others, fees may vary depending on personal circumstances. Please enquire for details.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

For workshop activities you will need to purchase your own safety footwear and protective clothing that meet the course requirements. For classroom activities you will need to provide stationary and writing materials.
