

## **Motor Vehicle Craft Training Level 2**



### **INTRODUCTION**

This course is aimed at those who are interested in gaining a Level 2 Motor Vehicle qualification.

### **WHAT WILL I DO**

Attend College on a full-time basis to study theoretical and practical motor vehicle engineering, along with complimentary studies and functional skills.

All units are assessed through a mixture of practical observations, assignments, phase tests and external on-line examinations.

All units must be successfully completed to achieve the qualification.

### **HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE**

The course will be studied full-time for one year or part-time over two years on a day release or evening basis.

### **ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS**

A relevant Level 1 vocational qualification or 4GCSE's at grade A- D to include Maths and English.

Applicants should provide a good reference and successfully complete an interview. Applicants will also complete an aptitude test, where they will have demonstrated abilities and an interest in the subject.

Entry to the Evening provision is through the Pre-Vocational evening course and associated assessment at the end of the course.

### **WHERE COULD IT LEAD**

Successful completion could lead to a Level 3 Motor Vehicle qualification or progression to an Apprenticeship in Vehicle Maintenance and Repair.

### **FEES**

Full time Courses are free for those who are under 19 on 31 August of the year they start their course. For others, fees may vary depending on personal circumstances. Please enquire for details.
