

Plumbing Craft Training Level 2



INTRODUCTION

This course leads to a Technical Certificate in Plumbing and aims to prepare you for employment and further training in the building services industry.

WHAT WILL I DO?

Topics covered are those that are required within the building services industry. These include the use of hand tools, portable power tools, threading equipment, safe use of bottled gases.

Skills covered will include the installation of:

- Low carbon steel tube and radiators
- Sheet lead roof work
- Hot and cold water supplies
- Bathroom installation

Facilities include a plumbing workshop with assessment areas and a learning resource room. All students have access to information on study skills and study support groups if required.

You will have a personal tutor to help support your learning. There are six externally set multiple choice examinations and various practical assessments. All work is assessed when required, by College-based assessors.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE

This course can be studied full-time for one year or part-time for 2 years during which you should achieve the Level 2 Technical Certificate in Plumbing. This qualification prepares you for the achievement of NVQ Level 2 (achievable from work based evidence).

ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

The Initial Craft Training Level 1 in Plumbing (National Award) is required. Students should successfully complete an interview. A good reference is required and must indicate good attendance and effort from the previous years study. Direct entry onto this course is 3 Grades C"s including Maths, English and Science.

WHERE COULD IT LEAD

Successful students will usually continue their training part-time to NVQ Level 2 and 3 whilst in employment in the industry.

FEES

Full time Courses are free for those who are under 19 on 31 August of the year they start their course. For others, fees may vary depending on personal circumstances. Please enquire for details.
