INTRODUCTION

This workshop will provide a basic introduction to choosing and using a digital camera, and using basic photo-editing software. The classes are kept to a maximum of 10 students led by an experienced tutor who will have ample opportunity to interact with the group.

WHAT WILL I DO

- Learn about the basic features of a digital camera such as Megapixels (resolution), Memory, Optical and digital zoom
- Camera shooting modes
- The options available for downloading (transferring) and printing your photos
- Installing photo editing software
- Basic photo editing including:
 - Correcting redevye
 - Cropping, brightening and straightening your photos
 - Sending photos as an attachment to an email
