What support funds are available for adults?

• <u>16-19 Bursary</u>

 For those aged 19 or over on 31/8/22 and hold an Education and Health Care Plan (EHCP) or are classed as a "19+ Continuer"

• <u>19+ Learner Support Fund (19+ LSF)</u>

• For those aged 19 or over on 31/8/22 who's course is funded through AEB

Loans Bursary Fund (LBF)

• For those aged 19 or over on 31/8/22 who's course is funded by an Advanced Learner loan





What support could I receive?

- <u>Travel</u>:
 - > mileage allowance paid weekly into your bank account <u>or</u>
 - Stagecoach Flexirider voucher
 - > Train or bus ticket costs paid into your bank account





What support could I receive?

• Books, equipment and uniform:

If awarded, we will cover these additional costs as charged to you by your Curriculum Area as follows:

> VAM materials – we will add credit into the College Art Shop for you

- > Other- If you require equipment or uniform, please speak to your tutor
- Registration fees will be paid directly to our Exams department





What support could I receive?

<u>Childcare fees</u>

- Depending on your financial circumstances, you may be awarded either 50% or 80% of your weekly costs up to a maximum of £100 per week
 - This is usually paid in arrears directly to your childcare provider when they send us an invoice
 - Alternatively, they may prefer that you pay them in full and claim your percentage refund from us using your receipt



What support could I receive?

• <u>Trips</u>

➢ Paid directly to the Curriculum Area if awarded and required

UCAS fee

>Refunded by bank payment to you upon production of a proof of payment

Application 'timeline'

- Submit a correctly completed and evidenced 16-19 Bursary, 19+ LSF or LBF application form
- Please allow 15 working days before contacting us regarding the progress of your application
- Receive a conditional award or award email sent to your personal email address as held on our system once an award has been authorised - Please be aware that no payment will be made until you are showing as enrolled on our system
- Please note that there will be a cut off for LBF applications this year 07/10/2022. This is due to limited funding
