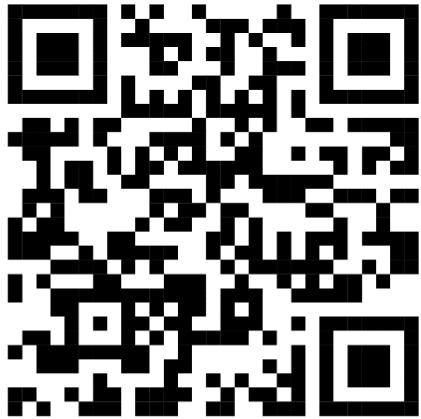
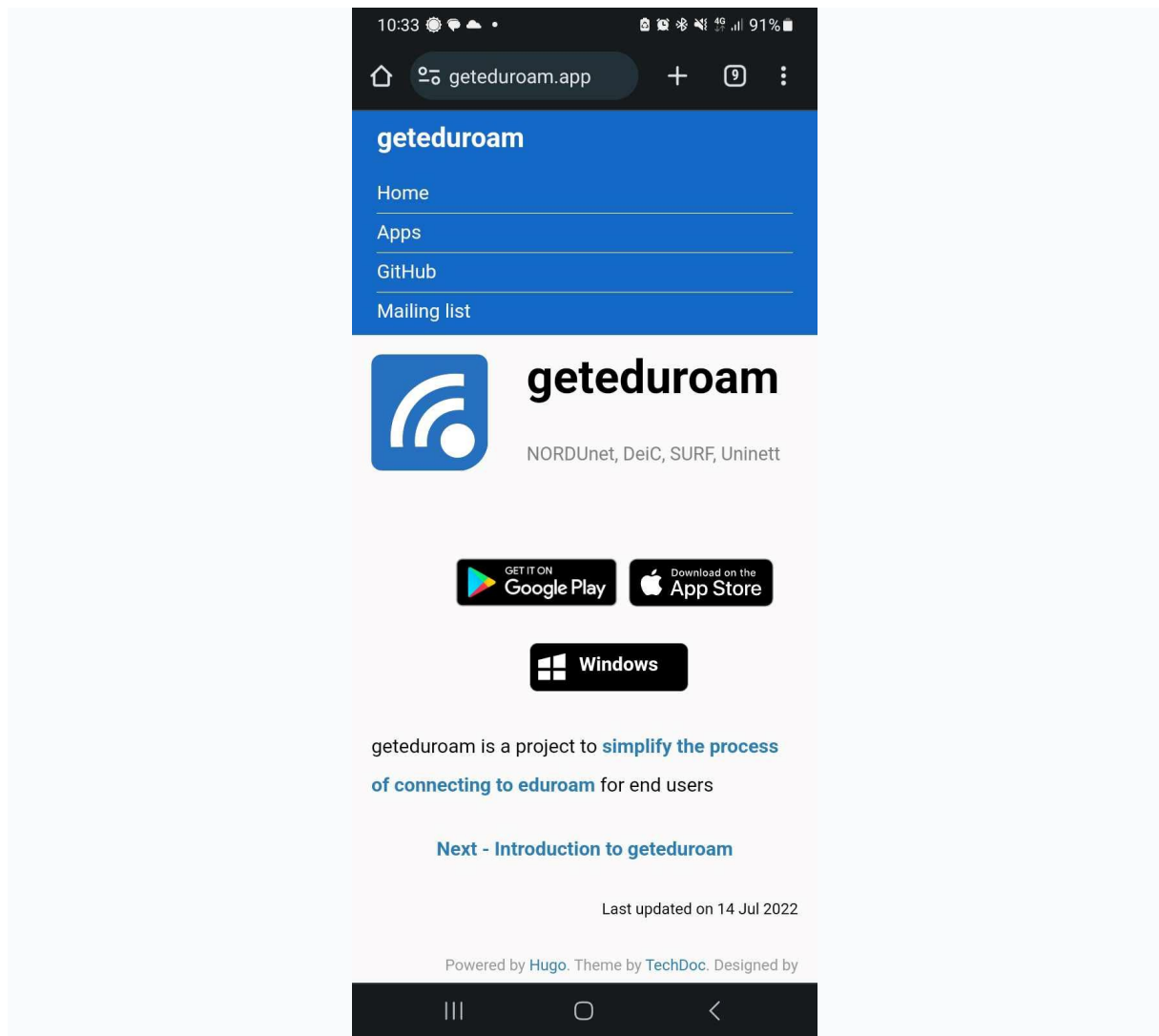


eduroam Setup Instruction Android

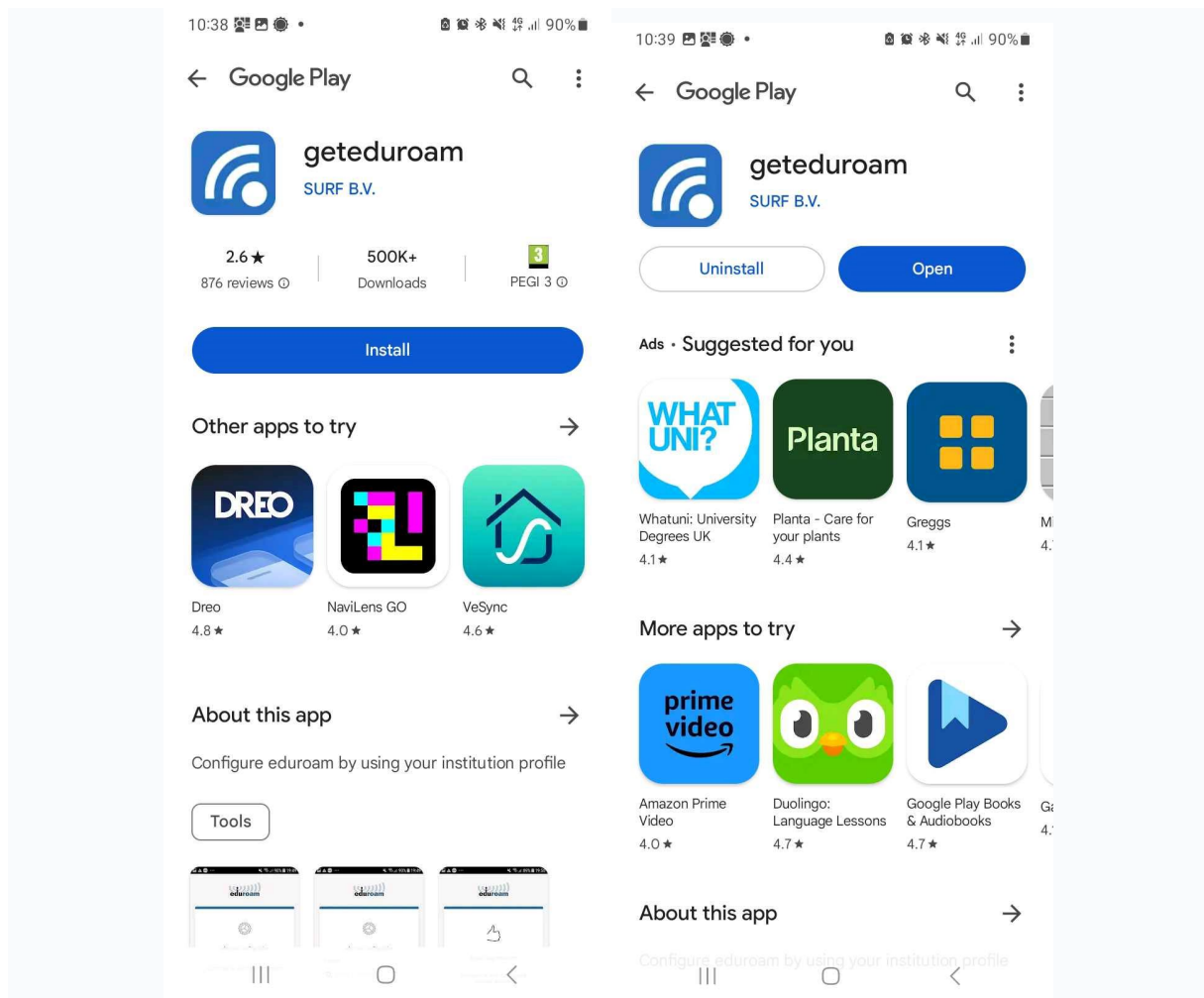
1. In order to get connected to eduroam, you must first connect to your mobile data OR the "**setup-eduroam-on-your-device**" wireless network. Once you're connected, please continue to **Step 2**.
2. Open **Chrome** or a different **browser** and navigate to the **Boston College Wireless Configuration Portal** at <https://geteduroam.app>



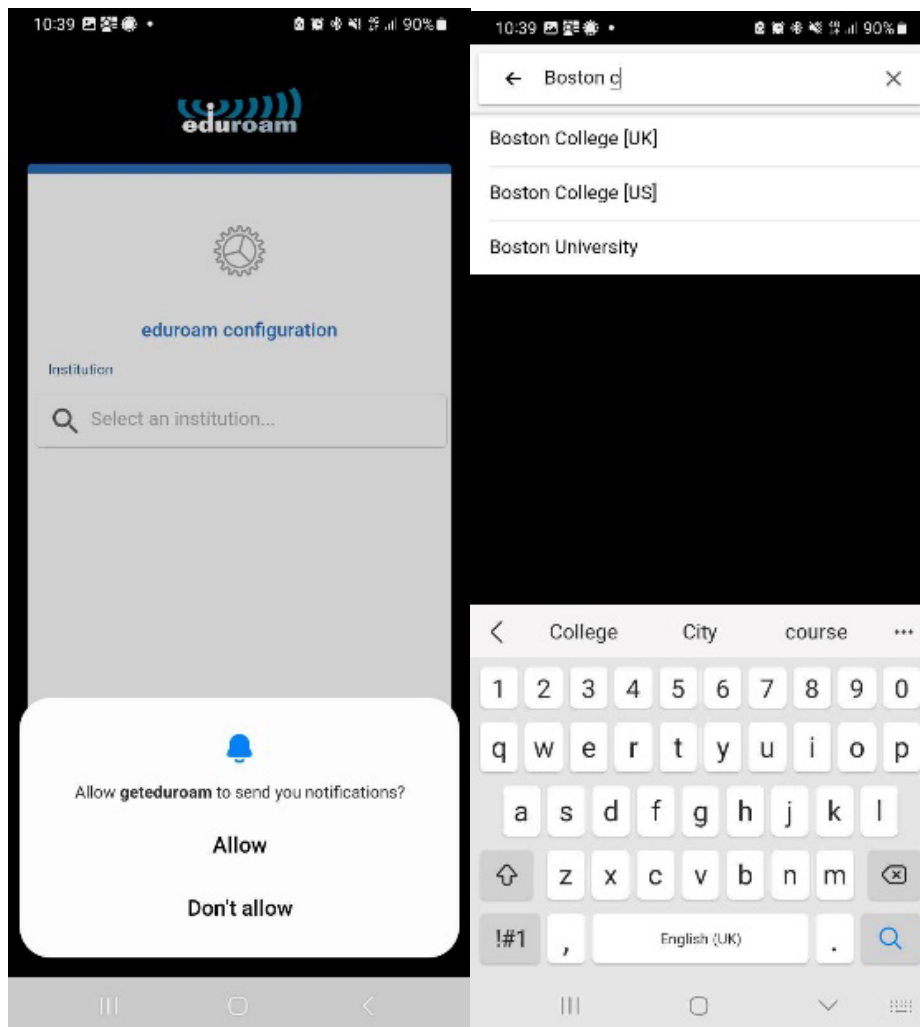
3. Click the appropriate **Download link for your device**



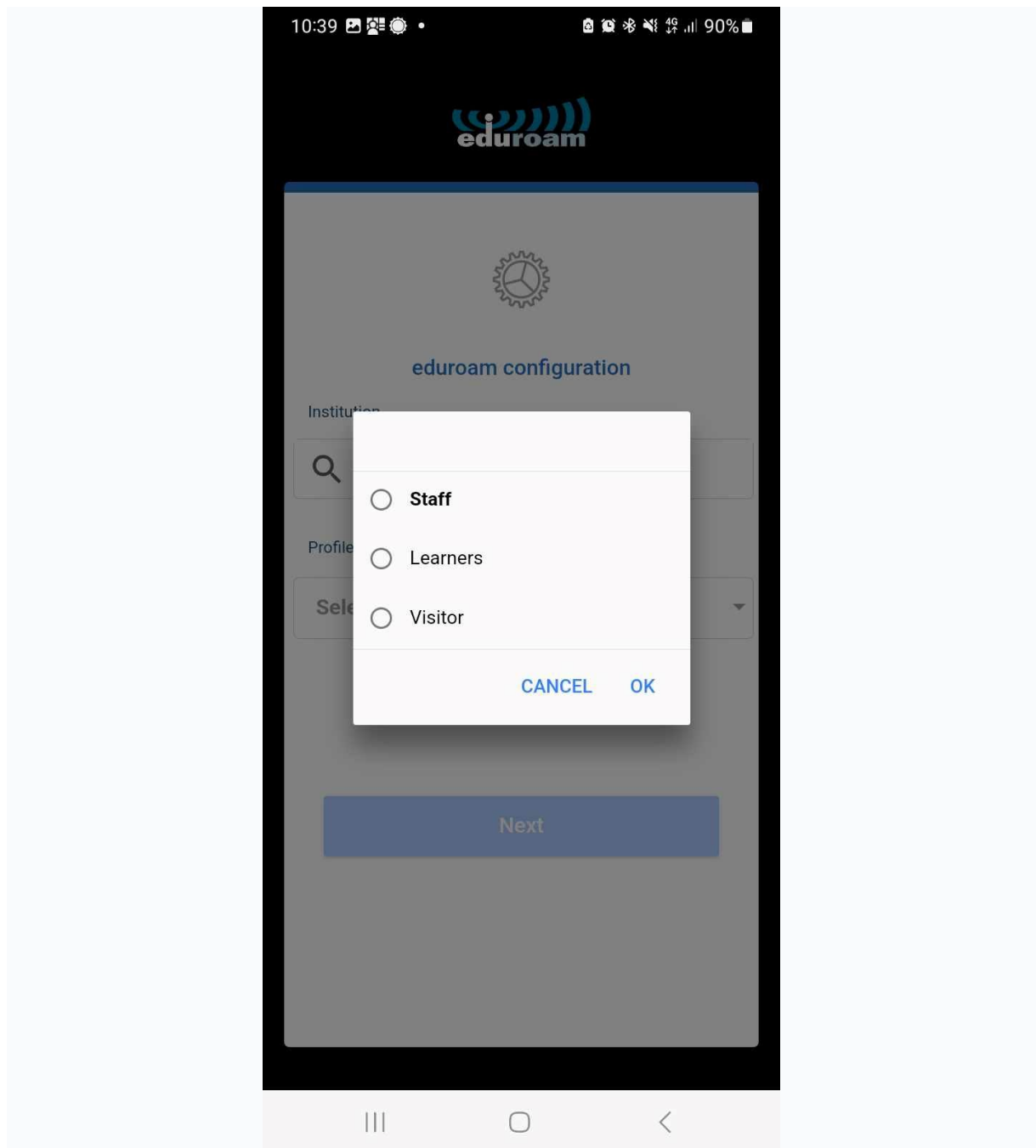
4. Open with 'Google Play Store' if prompted, click Install then Open.



5. Click **Allow** app and search for **Boston College [UK]**




6. Select whether you are **Staff**, **Learner** or **Visitor**.



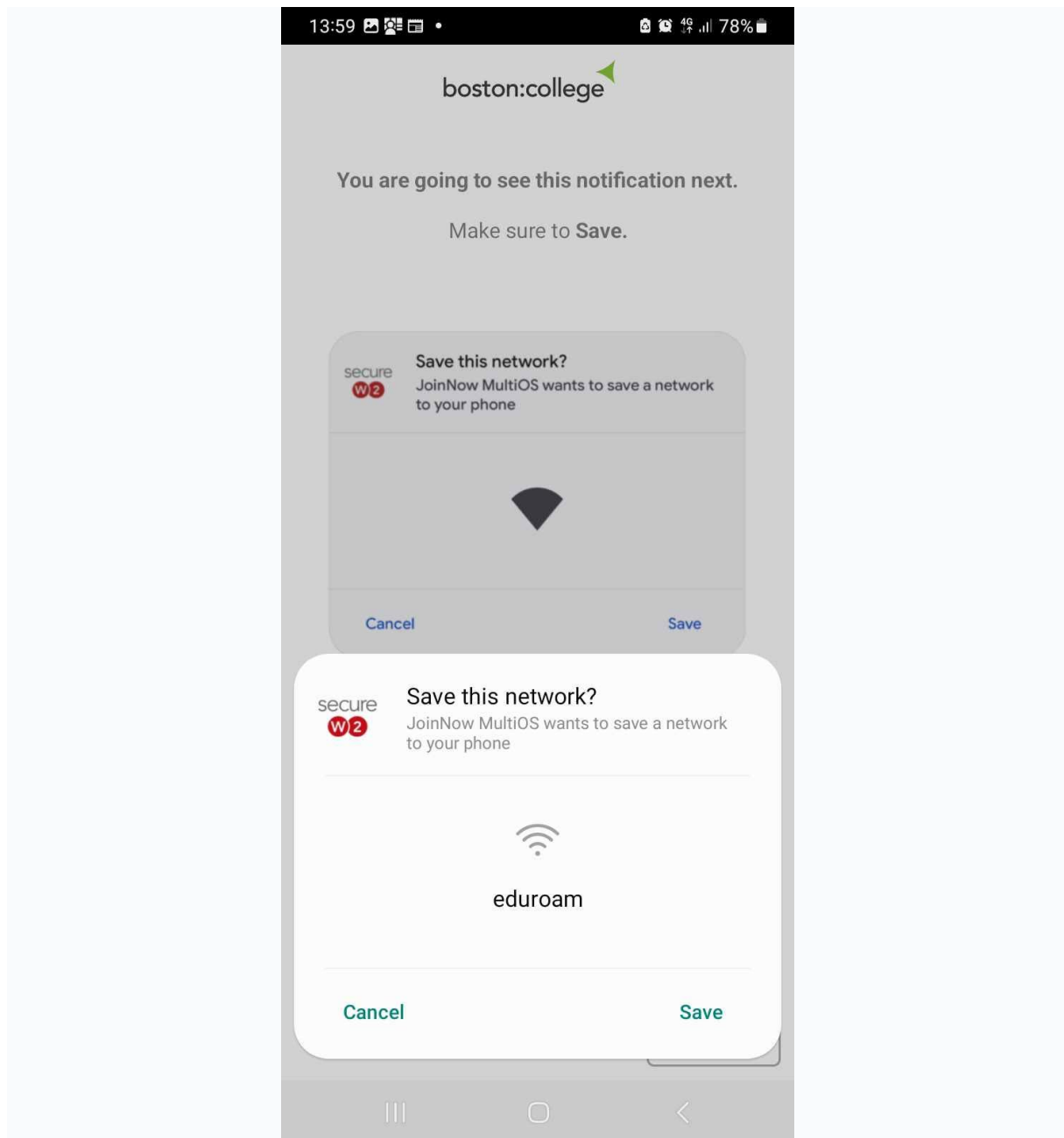
7. Enter your Boston College email address and password, then click **Connect to Network**
