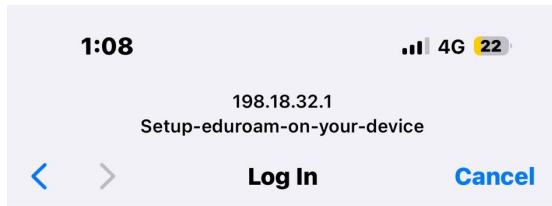


EDUROAM Setup Instruction iOS


3. After successfully connected to **setup-eduroam-on-your-device**, you will be redirected to the below page automatically. Then Tap on **App Store**


